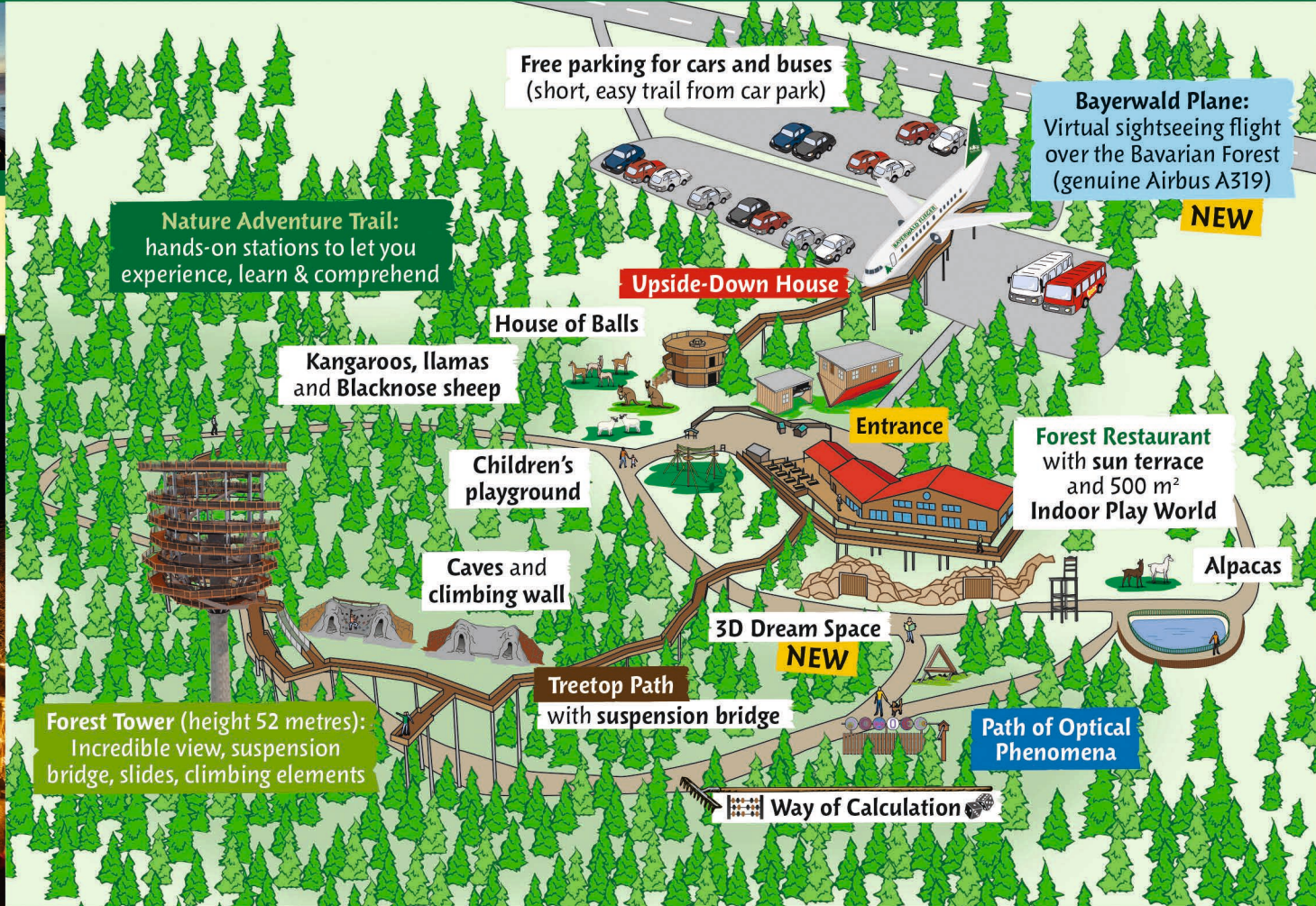

Experience the forest habitat from a completely new perspective

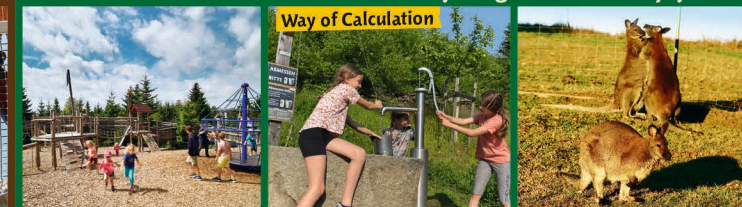


Accessible bridge made of larch wood up to a lofty height of 52 metres
